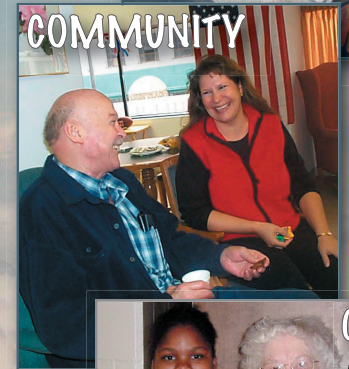
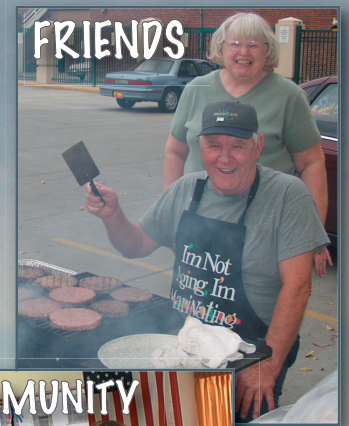


LINCOLN HOUSING CHARITIES
