NEW RECYCLING CENTER OPENS OCTOBER 1

Our area's city sponsored Recycling Center has been located on Lincoln Airport Authority property for a number of years.

Beginning on October 1, 2024 the Recycling Site will be relocated to a location on West Vine Street south of Northwest High School's football stadium. This will be one of the five large Recycling Sites as the City of Lincoln moves to consolidate from the 20 locations of the past.

Currently West Vine Street does not go through to NW 56th Street. It is intended that this connection

will be made in the near future. This will make access to the Recycling Site a bit easier for some of our residents

The opening of this site will close down four remaining Recycling Sites which include the ones at Highlands, West "O" and West "A".

This new Recycling Site will include more bins to sort your recycling into. Better lighting and better traffic flow will also be a benefit to this new site.

There will be surveillance of the site to help thwart illegal dumping

issues that have plagued many of the sites.

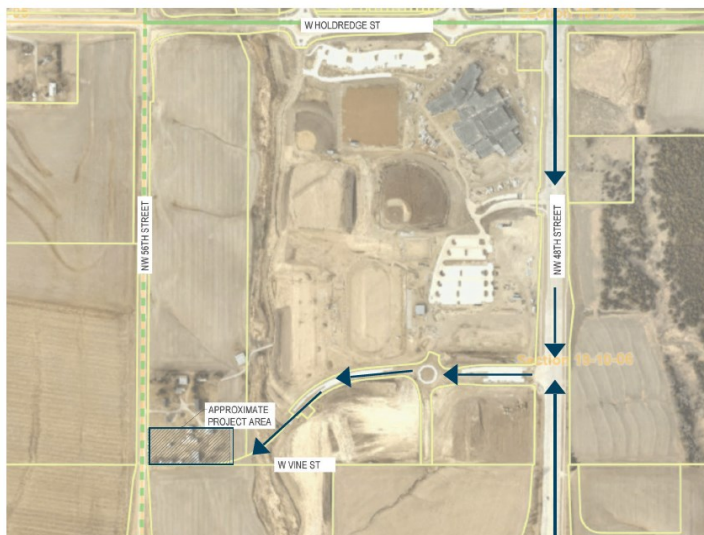
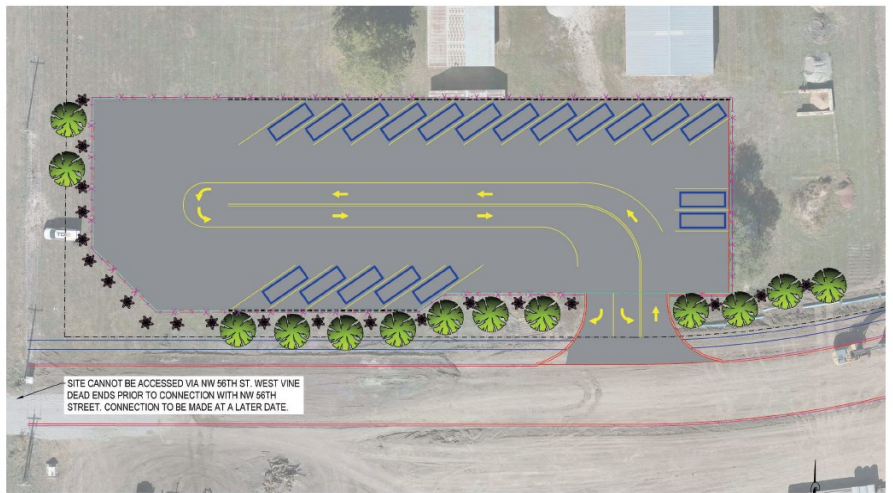
For many of us, the site on LAA property was very convenient. This site is a bit more out of the way, but we can be glad that it is still in a reasonable drive for the most of us.

What is different about the new, larger recycling site?

A lot! LTU is excited to offer more amenities at the new Northwest Recycling Site similar to other large recycling sites across Lincoln.

Amenities include:

- Increased lighting and landscaping
- More space and bins to recycle
- Large, standardized recycling roll-off bins (35 cubic yards)
- Surveillance monitoring to help thwart illegal dumping
- More parking close to the recycling bins



Drive to the New Site

To enter the new Northwest Recycling Site, head west on West Vine Street from Northwest 48th Street and turn north into the site. A connecting street from Northwest 56th Street to West Vine Street is planned for construction in the future.

Did You Know: LTU has seen recycling levels increase in the last two years thanks to the construction of larger recycling sites. Great job, Lincoln!
