

# Family Self-Sufficiency Program Support

Since 1993, Lincoln Housing Authority has operated the Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Program. To enhance those services, Lincoln Housing Charities responded to a call for proposals to increase services to immigrant and refugee families. With grant funds from the Building Strong Families Foundation, the FSS Program is able to provide financial assistance to these families to help with the cost of services needed to achieve self-sufficiency. Immigrant and refugee families face many challenges to self-sufficiency. Grant funds are used to help with the cost of English language classes at Southeast Community College. Other costs, often unique to immigrant and refugee families, are also considered on a case by case basis.

Lincoln Housing Charities receives and administers the grant funds for this program.
